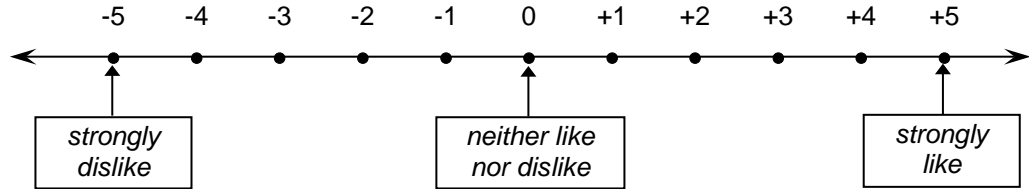

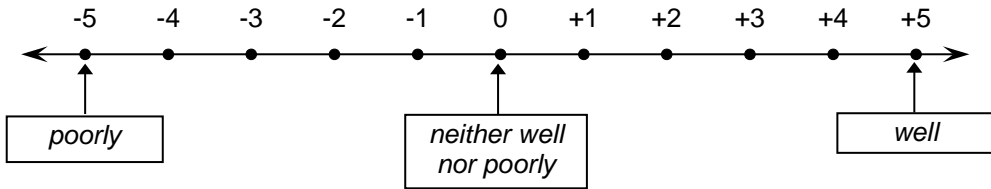

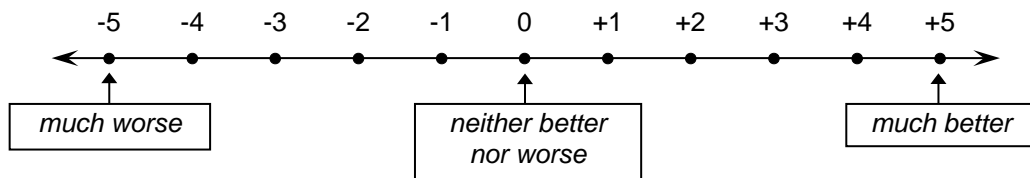


Respondents answer about how the government has performed since 2010








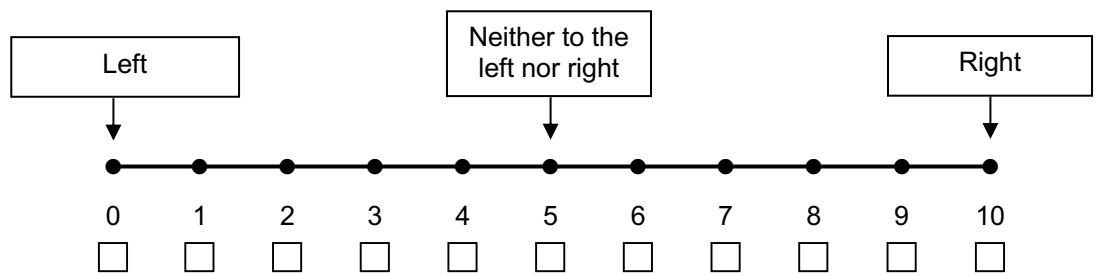
