Series Vallokalsundersökningarna (VALU) utförs på uppdrag av Sveriges Television, SVT, i

direkt anslutning till vallokalerna på valdagen. Väljare får svara på vilket parti de röstat på och genom undersökningen kan SVT under sin direktsända valvaka presentera prognos av

valutgången och analyser över det eventuella valresultatet.

VALU har genomförts i samband med nationella val sedan 1991, både vid riksdagsval, vid folkomröstningar och val till Europaparlamentet. Den första vallokalsundersökningen genomfördes av SVT i samarbete med Stockholms och Göteborgs universitet, sedan 1994 har samarbetet skett med Göteborgs universitet och Kungliga Tekniska Högskolan, KTH, i Stockholm. Göteborgs universitet har genom åren ansvarat för utformningen av intervjufrågor och analysen av resultatet och KTH har varit ansvariga för den statistiska planen, analyser och prognoser.

I VALU delas Sverige (valkretsarna) upp i geografiska regioner grupperade kring större högskolestäder. I var och en av regionerna engageras en högskolelärare som regional undersökningsledare. Undersökningsledarna fungerar som arbetsledare för de fältombud som genomför undersökningen i vallokalerna respektive de förtida röstningslokalerna. Samtliga undersökningsledare och fältombud har kunskaper i statistisk metodik.

#### Abstract

Denna vallokalsundersökning genomfördes i anslutning till Europaparlamentsvalet den 26 maj 2019. En vallokalsundersökning (exit poll) innebär att man frågar ett urval av väljare då de lämnar vallokalen dels vilket parti de röstat på och dels ett antal valsociologiska frågor. Undersökningsmetoden har med framgång använts i ett flertal länder för prognos- och analysändamål. Den första vallokalsundersökningen i Sverige genomfördes vid riksdagsvalet 1991. Liknande undersökningar har sedan dess genomförts i samband med samtliga riksdagsval, folkomröstningar och val till Europaparlamentet.

### Sampling

#### **Sampling Procedure**

Med hjälp av statistik rörande genomförd poströstning vid tidigare val från Posten respektive Valmyndigheten, och information från Valmyndigheten avseende de röstningslokaler som fanns för förtidsröstning vid Europaparlamentsvalet 2019, valdes 50 röstningslokaler för förtida röstning ut för att ingå i VALU 2019 EUP. Vid de utvalda röstningsställena fick de som förtidsröstade under ett slumpmässigt valt förmiddagsrespektive eftermiddagspass under undersökningsperioden 18-25 maj 2019 fylla i enkäten. Förmiddagspasset och eftermiddagspasset var tillsammans fyra timmar. Start- och slutpunkt för respektive pass valdes slumpmässigt. Under valdagen, 26 maj 2019, genomfördes undersökningen vid 100 valdistrikt (vallokaler). Valdistrikten var fördelade på de olika regionerna i enlighet med regionernas storlek vad avser antalet röstberättigade. Detta innebär till exempel att det i en region utvaldes fler valdistrikt än i de övriga tre regionerna. Inom varje region valdes så genom slumpmässigt stratifierat urval (stratifierat efter storlek och geografiskt läge inom regionen) de valdistrikt som skulle ingå i undersökningen. På detta sätt kom 100 valdistrikt att utväljas. För varje distrikt utvaldes därefter ett förmiddagspass och ett eftermiddagspass, vilka tillsammans utgjorde 3.5 timmar. Passens start- och slutpunkt valdes slumpmässigt.
