The Association was founded in 1995


Promote collaboration between HEIs and act on issues of common interest

General Assembly, Board, Presidium and a small office – approx. 30 permanent and temporary working groups



- 2. Provide <u>services and support</u> for the entire research process
- 3. A <u>culture of sharing</u> educational resources
- 4. Strive for <u>FAIR research data and research results</u>
- 5. Provide adequate and secure <u>infrastructural services</u>
- 6. Promote <u>cooperation</u> with other HEIs, infrastructures and funders
- 7. Promote and <u>participate</u> with <u>international initiatives</u>
- 8. Promote and develop <u>incentive structures</u>
- 9. Ensuring <u>copyright</u> vis-à-vis publishers

A complement to the Roadmap for Open Science


Established in 2022 and revised in 2024 due to a new recommendation

Contains 34 comprehensive proposals for actions linked to the nine recommendations

The proposed measures are set for 2022-2026

Provide overall support to all HEIs regardless of size or specialication


Annual follow-up 2023-2026 (survey) to see development over time





Find out how the HEIs are doing in their work

- Previous SUHF research data management survey 2018-2022
- New survey from 2023- 2026 based on the roadmap and the proposals in the guide
- Response options started (yellow), not started, implemented (green), don't know
- Work in progress in all areas
- Recommendation 7 (participation international initiatives) and 8 (incentive structures) have significantly fewer HEIs that have actively started the work according to the proposals
- Most HEIs find the road map and guide useful in their work

Orienteringskartan

- The "orienteering map" has been produced by SUHF/Research Data Group and Swedish National Data Service (SND). It is based on the Association of Swedish Higher Education Institutions' Roadmap for Open Science (2021:1)

- Available at SND Community Zenodo, SND website (at the moment only in Swedish)


